Term1: Week 9

Government of Tribal Federation in Canaan - Judges 1-21, Ruth 1-4

JUDGES 1

- 1 After Joshua's death, the Israelites plan to attack the Canaanites.
- The extent of their conquest, successful in parts but elsewhere incomplete:
- 2-7 Judah, with Simeon, attack the Perizzites and Canaanites, killing 10,000 at Bezek. They humiliate king Adoni-bezek.
- 8-9 They capture more southern cities & Jerusalem and Hebron.
- 10-15 Caleb gives his daughter to Othniel when he defeats Debir
- 16 The Kenites live among the people
- 17-19 Taking of further cities of Hormah, Gaza, Ashkelon and Ekron and areas in the hill country but not the valleys because of their iron chariots.
- 20 Hebron is given to Caleb
- 21 Benjaminites fail to drive out all in Jerusalem.
- 22-29 Sons of Joseph capture Bethel but do not drive the Canaanites completely from the land.
- |30-33 Zebulun, Asher and Naphtali could not drive out the Canaanites but lived among them or used them as forced labour.
- 34-36 The Amorites force Dan into the hills

JUDGES 2

The author's interpretation of the history of Judges. 2.1-3.6

- 1-5 At Bochim [Heb. Weepers] the angel of the Lord rebukes the people for their compromise of the covenant in their dealings with the inhabitants of the land.
- 6-9 While Joshua and his contemporary elders lived the people followed the Lord.
- 10-13 The new generation served other gods, forsaking the Lord.
- 14-15 The anger of the Lord allowed them to be distressed by enemies.
- 16 He pitied them and raised up judges but they frequently disobeyed.
- 20-23 The Lord let the Canaanites stay to test the Israelites.

JUDGES 3

- 1-4 The nations that were left to test Israel.
- 5-7 Israel made the Lord angry by intermarriage and idolatry.
- 8-11 Othniel delivers them from Cushan-rishathaim of Mesopotamia; peace for 40 years.
- 12-30 Ehud, a Benjaminite, delivers them from Eglon of Moab; peace for 80 years.
- 31 Shamgar saved Israel from the Philistines.

JUDGES 4

- 1-16 Deborah and Barak deliver them from Jabin a Canaanite king from Hazor and Sisera, his commander at Mt Tabor.
- 17-24 Jael kills Sisera with a tent peg.

- 1-31 Deborah and Barak's Song of victory
- 31 The land had peace for 40 years.

JUDGES 6

- 1-6 The Israelites, for their sin are oppressed by the Midianites for 7 years.
- 7-10 A prophet rebukes them
- 11-16 The angel of the Lord commissions Gideon of Manasseh to deliver them.
- 17-24 Gideon's offering is consumed with fire, causing him to build an altar naming it Yahweh-shalom [Heb. the Lord is peace].
- 25-27 Gideon pulls down the altar to Baal and the Asherah . He offers sacrifice to the Lord on the Lord's altar.
- 28-32 Joash, his father, defends him against the resultant anger of the townspeople, naming him Jerubaal [Let Baal contend against him].
- 33-35 The opposing armies of Midianites and Israelites gather.
- 36-40 Gideon asks God and is granted 2 signs with fleece.

JUDGES 7

- 1-8 Gideon's army of 22,000 is reduced to 300 by the Lord's command.
- 9-15 Gideon is encouraged by what he overhears from the enemy.
- 16-22 Using lamps in pitchers and trumpets at night, Gideon routs the Midianites .
- 23-25 The rest of Israel join in the pursuit, including Ephraim who take Zeeb and Oreb, two Midianite leaders.

JUDGES 8

- 1-3 Gideon pacifies the jealousy of Ephraim.
- 4-9 Succoth and Penuel refuse to feed Gideon's pursuing army.
- 10-12 The Midianite kings ,Zebah and Zalmunna are defeated.
- 13-17 Gideon returns to punish Succoth and Penuel.
- 18-21 He slays Zebah and Zalmunna to avenge his brothers.
- 22-23 He refuses to rule over Israel.
- 24-27 From the booty he makes a golden ephod, causing idolatry.
- 28 Midian is subdued. Peace for 40 years.
- 29-32 Gideon's harem, his 70 sons and death.
- 33-35 Again the Israelites fall into idolatry and ingratitude.

- 1-6 Abimelech, the son of Gideon by conspiracy with the Shechemites and murdering his 70 brothers, all except Jotham, is made king at Shechem.
- 7-21 Jotham by a parable rebukes them; foretells their ruin.
- 22-29 Gaal conspires with the Shechemites against Abimelech.
- 30-33 Zebul, leader of the city, reveals the plot to him.
- 34-45 Abimelech takes & destroys Shechem, sowing it with salt.
- 46-49 He burns the temple of Berith and the people hiding there
- 50-55 At Thebez, he is killed by a millstone.
- 56-57 Jotham's curse against Abimelech and the Shechemites is fulfilled.

JUDGES 10

- 1-2 Tola, from Issachar judged Israel for 23 years in Shamir.
- 3-5 Jair, from Gilead judged for 22 years; he had 30 sons.
- 6- Due to idolatry, God afflicts Israel through the Philistines and Ammonites for 18 years.
- 10-14 God hands them over to their false gods for help.
- 15-16 They repent; God takes pity on them.
- 17-18 The elders of Gilead look for a leader.

JUDGES 11

- 1-3 Background of Japhthah as an outcast.
- 4-11 The elders of Gilead ask him to be their chief at Mizpah.
- 12-28 Diplomatic messages of Japhthah with the Ammonites about disputed territory fail to get peace.
- 29-31 Japhthah makes a vow to the Lord.
- 32-33 He attacks and defeats the Ammonites.
- 34-40 On his return to Mizpah, he has to fulfill his vow in the person of his unfortunate daughter.

JUDGES 12

- 1-6 The Ephraimites quarrel with Japhthah; are defeated.
- 7 Jephthah judged 6 years and died.
- 8-10 Ibzan of Bethlehem judged after him for 7 years.
- 11-12 Elon of Zebulun judged 10 years.
- 13-15 Abdon judged 8 years; died and was buried in Ephraim.

JUDGES 13

- 1 The Lord gives Israel into the hands of the Philistines for 40 years because of their evil.
- 2-7 An Angel appears to Manaoh of Dan's barren wife; foretells the birth of a son, a Nazirite and a deliverer of Israel.
- 8-14 Manoah sees the angel and hears the same instructions for his wife and son.
- 15-23 He sacrifices to the Lord; the angel ascends.
- 24-25 Samson is born. The spirit of the Lord was on him.

JUDGES 14

- 1-4 Samson desires a Philistine woman from Timnah.
- 5-9 He kills a lion and later finds honey in the carcass.
- 10-14 At the marriage feast, he asks a riddle of the young men.
- 15-18 His new wife coaxes the answer from him to inform the men
- 19 In his anger, he slays 30 Philistines at Ashkelon.
- 20 His wife is given to another man.

- 1-2 Samson is denied his wife by her father.
- 3-5 Incensed, he burns the Philistines crops.

- 6 His wife and her father are burnt by the Philistines.
- 7-8 Still angry, he slaughters more Philistines.
- 9-13 Men of Judah bind him & deliver him to the Philistines.
- 14-17 He kills 1000 Philistines with a donkey's jawbone at Lehi named Ramath-lehi [i.e. the lifting up of the jawbone].
- 18-19 Being thirsty, God miraculously gives him water at En-hakkore [i.e the well of him who cried].
- 20 Samson judged Israel 20 years in Philistine days.

JUDGES 16

- 1-3 At Gaza, he escapes capture; takes away the city gates.
- 4-5 He falls in love with Delilah, who is bribed by the Philistines to find the secret of his strength.
- 6-14 3 times Samson evades telling her the secret of his hair.
- 15-21 Finally, he gives in and is then seized by the Philistines and blinded.
- 22-31 His strength returns; he pulls down the house of Dagon upon the Philistines and dies.

JUDGES 17

- 1-5 Micah of Ephraim steals silver from his mother, returns it; she makes images from it; he makes a shrine.
- In those days, everyone did their own thing.
- 7-13 He hires a Levite to be his priest.

JUDGES 18

- 1-2 The Danites send 5 men to seek out an inheritance.
- 3-6 At the house of Micah they consult Jonathan, the priest and are encouraged on their way.
- 7-10 They search Laish and on returning, encourage the Danites to conquer it.
- 11-26 600 men are sent; passing Micah's house, they go in, take his priest, images and consecrated things.
- 27-29 They win Laish and rename it Dan.
- 30-31 They set up idolatry there and make Jonathan priest.

JUDGES 19

- 1-15 A Levite goes to Bethlehem to fetch home his concubine.
- 16-21 In Gibeah, an old man offers him shelter for the night.
- 22-28 Men of Gibeah threaten him & abuse his concubine to death
- 29-30 He divides her body into 12 pieces and sends them to the 12 tribes.

- 1-7 At a general assembly at Mizpah, the Levite tells his story.
- 8-11 The assembled people decide to go up and punish Gibeah.
- 12-17 The Benjaminites support Gibeah against the rest of Israel
- 18-25 In 2 battles, the Israelites lose 40,000 men.
- 26-28 The Lord promises them victory
- 29-48 With strategy, they defeat the Benjaminites, destroy Gibeah and the

cities of Benjamin. Only 600 men escape.

IUDGES 21

- 1-7 The people mourn the desolation of Benjamin.
- 8-15 By the destruction of Jabesh-gilead, they provide for them 400 virgins as wives.
- 16-25 They advise the remainder to surprise and take as wives the virgins that danced at Shiloh each year.

RUTH 1

- 1-3 Elimelech of Bethlehem in Judah goes with his family, to Moab during a famine and dies there.
- 4-5 The sons, Mahlon and Chilion, marry Moabite women; also die
- 6-13 Naomi decides to return to Judah and tries to persuade her daughters-in-law to stay in Moab.
- 14-18 Orpah stays but Ruth with great constancy goes with her.
- 19-22 The two come to Bethlehem; they are welcomed back.

RUTH 2

- 1-3 Ruth gleans in the field of Boaz.
- 4-7 Boaz notices her.
- 8-17 He shows her great favour.
- 18-23 She brings the barley to Naomi who identifies Boaz as a close relative.

RUTH 3

- 1-5 Naomi advises her how to approach Boaz.
- 6-7 Ruth lies at Boaz's feet.
- 8-13 He receives her kindly; promises to marry her if a nearer kinsman refuses.
- 14-18 He sends her back to Naomi with 6 measures of barley.

RUTH 4

- 1-5 Boaz meets the kinsman before the elders to ask his intention about the redemption of the land and taking Ruth as wife.
- 36-8 The kinsman relinquishes his right to Boaz.
- 9-10 Boaz buys/redeems the inheritance.
- 11-12 The elders bless him.
- 13-17 Boaz marries Ruth; she has a son, Obed the grandfather of David.
- 18-22 The generations of Perez to David.
